# Kendal Polytechnic of Furniture and Wood Processing Industry

The Kendal Polytechnic of Furniture and Wood Processing Industry was established on 2 June 2018 under the Ministry of Industry, with the vision to become the leading industrial vocational education with great excellence and global competitiveness in the furniture and wood processing industry sector by 2030.

### Industrial Sector Background

The furniture and wood processing industry remains a strategic manufacturing economy which contributes to non-oil and gas sector GDP of around 51,58%. There are over 290,000 of business units and companies spread across various regions of Indonesia and a total supply chain of 1,4 million people (data: 2025). This sector offers significant growth opportunities, such as:

- Availability of an abundant workforce; access to raw materials, export-oriented ecosystems
- Main export markets: US, Japan, and EU. In 2024, furniture exports increase 3,2% from the previous year, reached 1,9billion USD.
- The trend of minimalist housing in urban areas and high demand for environmentally friendly products.

### Curriculum

The percentage of curriculum is 30% theory to 70% practice and applies a 3-2-1 system, which means 3 semesters on campus, 2 semesters on industry, and 1 semester on campus to finalize final project.

## Tracer Study

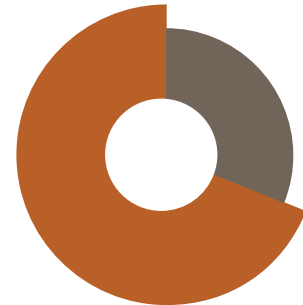
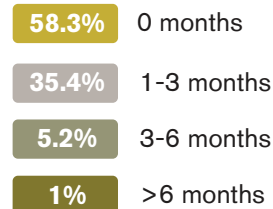
