- Main proposal (maximum 10 pages, font size Arial 11)
- Letter of motivation (Briefly explain why you are the most suitable for the consultancy service you applied for)

- Technical proposal
- Financial proposal
- Table of Content (ToC) for final report
- TIN, BIN and VAT certificate (as applicable)
- Trade license
- A signed statement testifying that all information contained within the proposal is correct and true
