

GREEN OFFICE

Environment protection: When waste is disposed of properly, you can prevent hazardous materials from contaminating the environment.

OBJECTIVE 1: Reducing electricity consumption

Lead by Rosa Ratha, ISA Junior Project Officer

- Maintain the temperature of all Air conditioners (AC) units not lower than 24°C.
- Turn off AC units and lights when no one in the office more than 1h.
- Keep the office doors closed, make sure we don't lose energy from AC flow loss (except during COVID-19).
- The last person to leave the office needs to make sure all the AC, light and printer are turned off.
- Replace regular light bulbs with LED bulbs, disable or exchange lamps that do not work with LED bulbs.
- Present office electricity bills every 3 months at whole team meeting.

OBJECTIVE 2: Reducing paper

- Print double-sided and monochrome (tones, tints and shades of a single color) instead of colored.
- Promote the habit of reusing one-sided print paper for notes, invoice preparin.
- Use soft copy as much as possible instead of hard copy.

OBJECTIVE 3: Reducing plastic usage

- Avoid as much as possible the use of water plastic bottle in meetings at Swisscontact office (PP and provinces) including meeting organised in hotels
- Avoid as much as possible bringing plastic bag, styrofoam containers, straw, water plastic bottle to office. Please find Green Restaurants in the list below.
- Purchase "nature friendly" cleaning products.

OBJECTIVE 4: Reducing environmental pollution

- Reduce traveling for long distance by organising meeting at the place where most participants stay; assess if physical meetings can be replaced with video conferences.
- Avoid traveling by plane on local mission if not necessary.
- Booking green hotels during the mission in provinces. Please see the list below.
- Keep your desk/office clean and green.
- Collaborate with office building to install classified dustbins.
